

Pre-arrival instructions: EC Online & Oxford Online Placement Test

Step 1: Log in to EC Online

- Visit <https://signin.ecenglish.com/student>
- Choose from the variety of log-in options
- Use your Student Reference Number and Date of Birth to verify your identity, and sign in to your personal account

Step 2: Take the Oxford Online Placement Test

This personally adaptive and powerfully accurate exam has been developed by our partners, Oxford University Press. The results will mark the starting point of your unique language-learning journey, and through EC Online, you can track your progress throughout. Then at the end of your course, you will receive an assessment of your overall proficiency and progress, externally validated by Oxford University Press.

- Click the 'Placement Test' banner on your home screen
- Click on 'Start the Test' when you're ready
- Select the initial test level. The difficulty in the test will automatically adjust according to the first few questions. Therefore, we recommend you start the test at 'Mid-level'
- Answer the questions. Most are multiple choice, but there are some questions which require longer answers to be typed using a keyboard
- The time limit is 80 minutes. A pop-up notification will let you know how much time you have left before the test is over

Step 3: Take the Needs Analysis Survey

Feedback is very important to us at EC, and this is the beginning of our interaction with you! The survey will tell us all about your personal goals and your reasons for learning English so we can start to plan the perfect EC experience, just for you.

- Be honest and tell us everything you can, because the more we know, the more we can help!

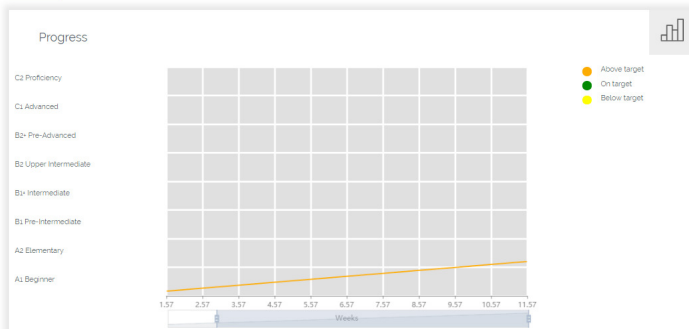
Step 4: Start Learning!
