Arrival and Departure Procedures at EC Malta



Arrivals



Students who book airport transfers will be met at the airport by a member of our EC Team to be taken to their chosen accommodation. Students staying with host families will be taken directly to their families to get acquainted.

Students staying in EC residences whose flights arrive Saturday and Sunday between the hours of 9 AM – 9 PM will be taken to EC Malta for a short introduction to the school.

There, they will:

- Be given the key to their apartment, shown the apartment guidelines, and will also leave their deposit
- Be shown the online placement test and encouraged to take it over the weekend, using their phone, laptop or school computers if they wish
- Be given a local SIM card if they require one and also given the option to purchase phone credit
- Be offered the opportunity to buy bus passes and air conditioning cards if needed
- Learn more about the Sunday welcome activity
- Have the opportunity to ask any questions

Following their welcome meeting, a dedicated driver will take the student to the apartment along with a member of staff who will show the student the apartment and complete a checklist ensuring that all important facilities are in order. Once the student is satisfied with their apartment, they will also sign the checklist.

Students staying in an EC residence whose flights arrive outside of these times will be greeted at the airport by an EC Member of Staff. They will then be taken to EC Malta to collect welcome pack containing the key for the accommodation, the apartment guidelines the school emergency number and a SIM card as well as instructions for adding credit to their SIM card online if needed. The residence deposit will be collected on the following Monday at school. The driver will then take the student directly to the residence. Posters are displayed in each of the apartments to inform the students about any important information or instructions specific to their accommodation such as the Wi-Fi passwords, garbage collection and cleaning schedule.

Departures



Residence check out time is 10 AM on Saturdays and Sundays

Residence Students whose flights depart at 2 PM or later on Saturday or Sunday will be collected at 10 AM with their luggage from their apartment and brought to the school. Students will be able to leave their luggage in a safe and locked area of the school and will then be free to go and enjoy their final day. They will be asked to return to the school 3 hours before their flight to meet their transfer to the airport. Students are welcome to use the school facilities including the café on the day of their departure.

Students staying in hotels or with host families, or those who are departing a residence on Saturday or Sunday on a flight departing before 2 PM or at any time on a weekday will be collected as normal 3 hours before their flight and taken directly to the airport.
