Adult Centres

I/We hereby authorise my/our son/daughter to attend the Adult Programme and understand that this is a programme for students of legal adult age and over of different nationalities. I/We also understand that EC does not provide 24-hour supervision and that the programme allows students to make their own arrangements during free slots on their timetable.

Classic Young Learner programmes

I/We hereby authorise my/our son/daughter to attend the Classic Young Learner programmes and understand this is a residential/homestay programme for 12 to 17-year-old students of different nationalities. I/We also understand that whilst EC is committed to safeguarding and child protection, the programme allows students to make their own arrangements during free slots on their timetable.

Summer Camp Programmes

I/We hereby authorise my/our son/daughter to attend the Classic Young Learner programmes and understand this is a residential programme for 7 to 12-year-old students of different nationalities.

Freestyle programmes

I/We hereby authorise my/our son/daughter to attend the EC Freestyle Programme and understand this is a residential programme for 17 to 20-year-old students of different nationalities attending EC Malta to learn English. I/We also understand that EC does not provide 24-hour supervision and that the programme allows students to make their own arrangements during free slots on their timetable.

Day programmes

I/We hereby authorise my/our son/daughter to attend the EC Classic/Summer Camp Day Programme and I will take full responsibility and personally supervise the student outside lesson and activity times.

Declaration

As the parent or legal guardian of the above-named student, I hereby give EC English Holdings Ltd. (and their respective agents, employees, volunteers, promoters and affiliates, all EC Centres) permission to include this student on field trips/activities/excursions accompanied by EC staff/representatives.

I understand and accept that the EC staff and students will be travelling on foot or by plane, train, bus, boat, car or van to their destination.

EC will take care of the above-named student. However, I acknowledge that on adventurous field trips/activities/excursions such as the ones EC will involve the students in, accidents do occasionally happen, and I accept that my family and I will not bring a claim against EC for death or personal injury unless EC is shown to have failed to maintain its duty of care.

As the parent or legal guardian of the above-named student, I have procured for them such adequate insurance as may be required to provide cover for the loss and/or damage to all the possessions they take with them on EC field trips/activities/excursions, and that, in the event that they suffer loss and/or damage, I will therefore not make a claim against EC for that loss and/or damage.

For the avoidance of doubt nothing in this waiver will limit any of the liability EC may have for death or personal injury arising as a result of EC negligence. I acknowledge that I have read this statement carefully before signing this consent form, and provide my permission to include this student on field trips/activities/excursions by signing it.

To the best of my/our knowledge, my/our son/daughter is in a good state of health. Whilst all appropriate precautions will be taken for the safety of my son/daughter, any loss, damage or harm to my son's/daughter's person and/or personal belongings that may arise from the programme shall be exempt of all recourse.

EC will endeavour to contact parents in case of any emergency. However, should my son/daughter require medical treatment or hospitalisation during his/her stay on this programme the attending physician and/or hospital is authorised to treat my/our son/daughter.

I/We understand that students residing in EC accommodation may be required to travel to and from the accommodation via public transport and that, though EC will give guidance and advice, this travel will be unsupervised and at the student's expense.

I/We give EC English Language centres the absolute right and permission to publish, copyright, distribute and use pictures and/or videos of my child (or pictures taken by my child) for any purpose which may include, among others, advertising, promotion, marketing and packaging for any EC product or service. I understand that these photos will not be used for any other than EC purposes and agree that images may be combined with other images or footage, text and graphics, and cropped, altered and modified. If my child does not wish to be part of photo or video content it will be their responsibility to absent themselves.

I/We have read and discussed the following guidelines with my/our son/daughter and acknowledge that he/she has agreed to follow the programme guidelines and further agree that the staff of EC reserve the right to expel my child from the programme in the event of any guideline violation.

Accommodation rules

- Students must keep their room neat and tidy
- Students must not allow anyone other than those allocated to that room to sleep over
- Students are not allowed to sleep out even if their friends happen to be at another EC residence
- Students are not allowed to invite guests into the residence
- Girls are not allowed to stay in boys' rooms and vice versa
- Students are not allowed to smoke in residence
- Students must not make excessive noise that could disturb other guests
- Students are liable for any damages/breakages caused to property. Payment for damages must be effective immediately and the residence staff will not allow the students to leave the residence unless payment has been made
- Students must pay directly for any additional services such as phone calls/room service
- Students must return keys to reception when they are leaving the residence

EC reserves the right to expel and repatriate a student at his/her own expense for any of the reasons below.

This includes but is not limited to the following circumstances:

- Possession of any illegal drugs
- Possession of weapons of any kind
- Excessive alcohol consumption
- Malicious damage to school property or place of accommodation
- Repetitive disruptive behaviour in class
- Repetitive absenteeism from academic lessons
- Repetitive disregard for EC's rules and regulations
- Breaking local laws
- If a student is a danger to his/her own safety or that of other students
